# The Purpose for these Meetings :

Kingdom Discipleship for Ministers is birthed out of a burning desire to help brethren who are in pastoral ministry to "lengthen the cords and strengthen the stakes" in preparation for purposeful kingdom advance. God's message to the church in Sardis was, "be watchful and strengthen the things that remain, that are ready to die: for I have not found thy works perfect before God". (Rev 3:2)

We want to gather in recognition that there are many ways in which we in Anabaptist-type churches are also falling short and in need - we desperately need to hear from God and recommit ourselves to the vision of Kingdom Christianity set forth in the life and message of Jesus. This message is being attacked, diluted, and weakened by materialism, individualism, and the influence of modern Christianity. We need to examine and strengthen the foundations.

The messengers of this kingdom are also being afflicted with weariness of body, turmoil and unrest in their spirit, needs in their homes, confusion in the churches, and distractions from the world. These messengers and shepherds need time to come away and be refreshed, purified in spirit, pastored, and equipped so that they can pour out their lives to others.

Enlarge the place of thy tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of thy habitations: spare not, *lengthen thy cords and strengthen thy stakes.* Isaiah 54:2

Our desire is:

#### To Strengthen the Stakes

- To examine, clarify, and reaffirm the foundations of the faith - so that the minister can teach and disciple with a clearer purpose and greater assurance
- To minister to the heart of ministers and encourage a Christ-like spirit of love and humility — so that the minister can serve in the truth and with a right spirit
- To broaden ministers' understanding of, and love for, God's word — so that the minister is better prepared to accurately expound the whole counsel of God
- To equip ministers for more effective preaching and pastoring of God's people So that the minister can know a greater anointing and fruitfulness in shepherding the flock

### To Lengthen the Cords

• To establish broader relationships with brethren who can help each other to greater faithfulness

- To be discipled by those who are making progress in areas where we are weak
- To break down walls of criticism and begin to honor, respect and learn from others of similar faith
- To seek God's will together concerning His purpose and the advance of His kingdom
- To fellowship, encourage and inspire each other

While brothers from various church affiliations are invited, we do not intend this to be an ecumenical conference. Rather it is intended to strengthen the function of each of our Anabaptist groups. We desire to promote a spirit of humility and brokenness throughout this week of meetings in relating to one another.

## The Method

### Pass it on – by teaching

- Foundational teaching: to provide a solid, Bible-based, Anabaptist understanding of the faith
- Practical teaching: to provide insight and equipping for pastoral ministry, study & preaching

### Pass it on – by living

We seek to equip men with a kingdom vision, a pastoral compassion, a sensitive spirit, a love for truth, and a passion for preaching — by being with other men whose hearts beat with some of the same desires.

Our desire is not that the teachers simply share some information for which they have studied, but rather share from the outflow of their lives: what they feel meets the need of the hour, and what will strengthen areas in which our churches and ministers are most weak.

We learn most as we come alongside each other and travel together up to the mountain of the Lord.

### Pass it on – by digging in ourselves

Paul's instruction to Timothy to "take heed unto thyself, and unto the doctrine", is still an essential commission upon God's ministers today. We desire that the environment and interaction in these meetings encourage and challenge us in our own responsibility to be faithful in the ministry of God's Word.
